Implementation of Measures to Contain Coronavirus (COVID-19) Infections

dated 15.3.2020

Deadlines for Bachelor and Master theses Physics, Astrophysics

The cancellation of examinations does not apply to Bachelor and Master theses, until further notice. These should continue to be possible. The rules concerning restricting the spread of Corona infections are to be strictly followed. Given the major restrictions to be followed by research groups, institutes and the university, the following supplemental rules are valid until further notice for all Bachelor and Master theses with a **submission deadline 20 March 2020 and later**:

1. the submission deadline for all Bachelor theses is extended by 4 weeks;
2. the submission deadline for all Master theses is extended by 6 weeks;
3. if, in special cases, the default extension is not enough to compensate for the anti-coronavirus measures, a further extension can be granted. The request for such an extension should be submitted in writing to the examination board and requires the consent of the 1st supervisor;
4. requests for extensions that are already covered by the examination regulations are not affected by these new across-the-board extensions and can be submitted as usual;
5. documented illness will still be taken into account for the submission deadline;
6. the three copies of the thesis that are submitted via registered mail (Einwurf-Einschreiben) to the Examination Office do not have to be bound if the pages are securely fixed together.
7. Alternatively the thesis can be submitted electronically as a single PDF document to the Examination Office (zapf@uni-bonn.de). The declaration of independent research has to be signed electronically, e.g. using a scanned signature.
