

Information regarding exam phases of Summer Semester 2021 for students and instructors of Physics/Astronomy

For the exam phase the regulations of the winter semester essentially remain unchanged:

- As a general rule, exams are purely online.
- Exceptions are tightly limited and permitted only after individual approval through the rectorate.
- Instructors inform on exceptions individually for the corresponding modules.

Free attempts

Deviating from the University regulations, for the study courses in Physics/Astrophysics the extensive regulation regarding free examination attempts of summer semester 21 remains in force: If the written (or as a substitute oral) exam of a module results in a failure (i.e. neither of the two exams of the pair of exams in summer semester 21 has been passed), then this will not be counted for the maximum number of possible examination attempts. This is independent on whether such a free attempt has already been taken before for the same or any other module.

Flood tragedy

Should students be directly or indirectly affected by the flood tragedy, every measure will be taken by the examination board to avert further disadvantages. Therefore:

- Students: Please stay registered for the exams (if necessary, the examination office will later deregister you to prevent no-show failures), and
- contact your instructors as soon as is possible.
- Instructors: Please collect and forward the information to the examination office.
- On that basis the examination board together with the students will decide on the best possible support to further organise the examinations.
